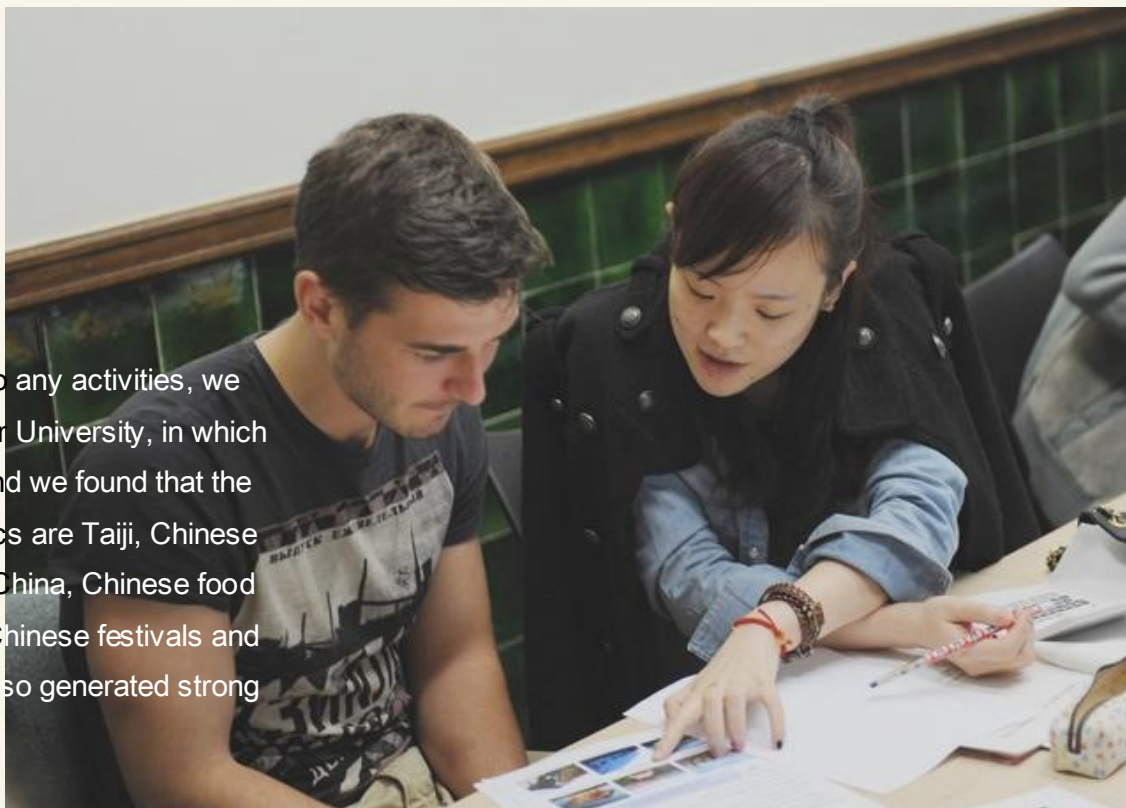


Interest Survey

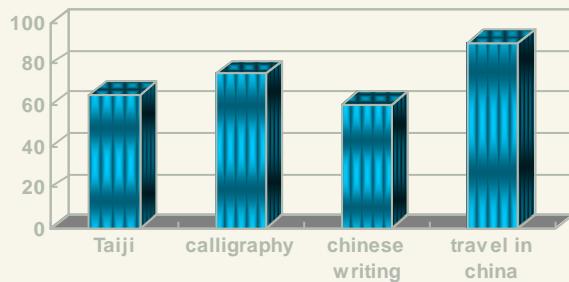

A Bangor student responding to the survey with the help of a Chinese student.



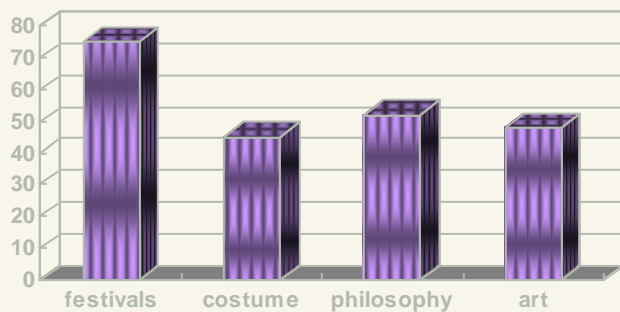
The findings are as follows

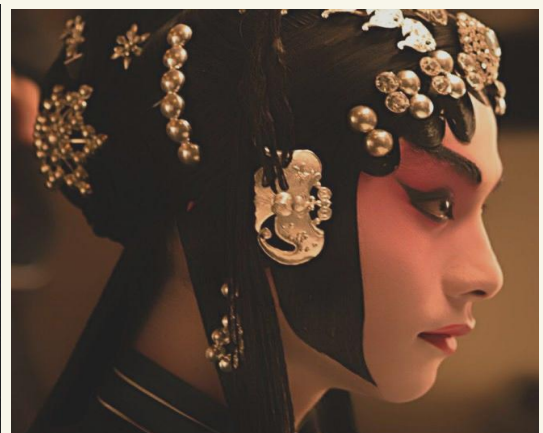
